To test for competency, the student must at least complete an exam with a minimum of two images (separate views). Students will be asked to simulate GI exams at least once prior to competency testing on UGIs too. BE/ACBES have been this way for a few years now.</p> <p>We are developing a competency for an alternative GI post-surgical intervention, i.e., gastric sleeve; esophageal cancer; and perforations/tears to rule out leaks.
