<p>1. Program Director and Students are not allowed to be in the hospital for class or clinical as of March 24th, 2020. They went on spring break a week ago and are not being allowed to return for their own safety. This is not going to be a short lived issue.</p>			
<p>2. I will have student evaluations remotely(through Google Meets) and discuss with each student individually how we will be continuing with classes.</p>			
<p>3. Ken and Jennifer were requested to be prepared to start teaching using Google meets as of April 6th. Ken will go down to one day of radiographic procedures and Patti will teach Ethics during this time to complete a course that is easily taught online.</p>			
<p>4. April retests are suspended until we can return to the hospital.</p>			
<p>5. MRI April start will begin with remote courses in April; Cross-sectional anatomy; and Physics will begin. Clinicals are postponed until students can return to the hospital.</p>			
<p>6. Mammography student will continue coursework remotely, but clinical is postponed until we can return to the hospital.</p>			
<p>7. The disaster plan will be updated for the new class once we have input from the administration about how/when we will be allowed to move forward.</p>			
<p>8. In-coming class was informed of their acceptance and was also informed that their start date was dependent upon when we are allowed to return to the clinical site.</p>
