General: The Section of Orthopedics is in an excellent position to present to students a comprehensive outline of the spectrum of orthopaedic surgery as practiced in a community hospital. There is a large volume of elective orthopaedic surgery done at Ascension Providence Hospital, as well as a very active Emergency Department presenting a variety of orthopaedic trauma.

Goals & Objectives:

Duties to expect:

- Daily rounds starting at 6:30am
- OR case coverage – 1st assist duties
- ER/floor consults - if OR is covered, check with floor mid-level for assistance
- ER/floor new admissions - if OR is covered, check with the floor mid-level for assistance
- Post-operative checks for every case scrubbed
- Floor procedures - assistance with fracture reduction and casting, joint aspirations/injections
- Sign out at the end of the day with floor mid-level staff

Orthopedic Conferences:

- Student/Resident Interesting Cases (1st Thursday of the month)
 - Present on case during the rotation-preferably a case the student scrubbed.
- Attend all orthopedic conferences (every Thursday at 7:30am)

Case Coverage:

- Total Joints
 - Hip replacement
 - Knee replacement
- Trauma/Fractures
 - Hip fractures
 - Lower extremity fracture
- Upper Extremity Fractures
 - Upper Extremity
 - Shoulder/elbow
 - Arthroscopic procedures
 - Knee/Shoulder
 - Spine surgery

Evaluation: At the end of the rotation, the Rotation Director will collect data from the supervising physician and other medical team members and complete a written evaluation of the student that is reflective of the student's academic competence, procedural proficiency and professional attributes. The standard medical school form from the student's medical school will be used. If required, the student should complete a case log and an evaluation of the rotation and submit them to their medical school.
